What information do we collect?

- 3) To collate statistical information about our website.

Cookies

Cookies are small pieces of information that are stored by your browser on your computer's hard drive. Use and disclosure of personal information

We use personal information to process brochure requests, deal with feedback and call back facilities.

We will only hold personal data on our systems for a strictly limited period of time. For the most part the time period will be set as a matter of internal policy and will be the minimum necessary for our use.

Access to your personal information

Security of personal information

Disclosure of Data to Third Parties

At each point of data collection, users are given the appropriate means to opt-out of having their personal data passed on to selected third parties.
